- 6. WARRANTY IS TOO SHORT
- 7. TOO DIFFICULT TO CONTACT FOR SERVICE WHEN NEEDED
- 8. NEVER HEAR FROM INSTALLER ONCE IT IS INSTALLED
- 9. SLOPPY INSTALLATION, LOOKS TERRIBLE
- 10. LACK OF COLD WEATHER KIT

- 4. WHAT IS THE LEAD TIME TO FIX THE UNIT
- 5. ARE YOUR TECHS FACTORY TRAINED
- 6. DOES IT INCLUDE A COLD WEATHER KIT
- 7. IS THE RECOMMENDED BATTERY GOING TO BE INSTALLED
- 8. IS THIS YOUR PRIMARY BUSINESS
- 9. DO YOU HAVE REFERENCES YOU CAN GIVE ME TODAY
- 10. ARE YOUR INSTALLERS LICENSED IN THE STATE OF MAINE
- 11. WHAT IS THE ENCLOSURE MADE OF
- 12. DO YOU HAVE PICTURES OF SOME OF YOUR INSTALLATIONS
- 13. DO YOU HAVE TESTAMONIALS I CAN READ WITH YOU
- 14. HOW OFTEN DO YOU STAY IN CONTACT WITH ME AFTER THE SALE
- 15. DO YOU HAVE A DEDICATED STORM NUMBER
- 16. WHAT SIZE INVENTORY ON SPARE PARTS DO YOU CARRY
